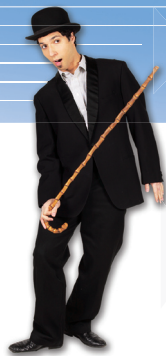


Theatre Arts Academy

Theatre Arts Academy Course Work

Fundamentals of Acting (THE103)

Learn basic acting techniques and become comfortable with monologues and auditioning. As a student actor, you will strengthen your sense of self, including self-confidence, self-discipline, organization, creativity, and oral-visual communication skills. Tuesdays and Thursdays from 2:10-3:30PM. Instructor: Maryanne C. Arena. Topics include:

- ▷ Voice and articulation
- ▷ Heightening awareness of the five senses
- ▷ Basic movement & choreography
- ▷ Self confidence and creativity
- ▷ Self and body awareness
- ▷ Identifying objectives
- ▷ Confronting obstacles



Stagecraft (THE106)

Discover the basic theories and techniques of design, construction, and painting of theatre sets, and appreciate the organization and operation of production crews. Mondays and Wednesdays from 2:10-3:30PM. Instructor: Edward R. Hallborg. Topics include:

- ▷ History of theatre facilities
- ▷ Basic stage and scene construction and use of power tools
- ▷ Safety in the theatre and scene shop
- ▷ Basic drafting
- ▷ Scene painting and use of color

High school students attend integrated classes with current Genesee students and earn high school elective credits, as well as college credits. Students in the ACE program are offered a discount from the regular Genesee Community College tuition rate.



Learning at Genesee

You will be taught by college professors with extensive background and experience in theatre and the performing arts industry. In addition, you will have the chance to study and perform in the Genesee Center for the Arts, a state-of-the-art performing arts space. At the culmination of the academy program, you and your fellow students will produce a live performance.

Facilities

Since it opened in 1991, Genesee Center for the Arts has been the cultural center of our community. At the heart of the Arts Center is the Stuart Steiner Theatre, a beautiful 328-seat facility that is accessible for special needs audiences and host to a wide array of performances throughout the year.
